The Mid-Michigan Chapter of the Chartered Property Casualty Underwriters Society (CPCU), an organization for insurance professionals, offers scholarships for college students attaining their junior or senior status, or pursuing their master's degree, during the 2023-2024 academic year and have a demonstrated interest in entering the insurance field.

Two scholarships will be awarded by the Society this year. Each student will be awarded a \$1,000 scholarship. The scholarships will be for the 2024 – 2025 academic year.

The scholarship application requirements are as follows:

- Cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher
- Insurance related major of study or related interest (i.e. Actuarial Science, Business, Information Technology)
 - If major is other than insurance related, an internship or employment in the insurance industry is required
- Junior or Senior class standing or pursuing master's degree for 2024 – 2025
- Unofficial transcript through Fall 2023
- Resume and completion of the application
- One letter of recommendation from a professor, advisor, or employer
- Photo suitable for business publication

Applicants awarded the scholarships will be invited to attend a CPCU Society chapter luncheon meeting in fall 2024.
